

Collaborative learning opportunities to apply for funding



The United Nations Development Fund invites civil society organisations to apply for project funding. To get your organisation to be considered for this funding you have to first write a proposal in the UN's preferred language (English, Hindi and Kiswahili) and then submit it to the UN's website. UNFPA supports women's leadership and women's political voice, rights and advocacy by participation of all groups in democratic processes. The large majority of UNFPA funds go to civil society organisations. In this way, UNFPA gives a distinct role to complementing the UN's other work – the work with Governments – in strengthening democratic processes around the world.

There is a Toolkit available for download by UNFPA, which provides a guide to apply for UNFPA UNFPA projects. UNFPA has supported over 100 groups in over 100 countries to fund women of about 100000 women. Projects are related to a range of issues including gender, violence against women and girls, reproductive health, HIV prevention, law, justice, UNFPA's other project proposals covering areas in these things are as follows:
